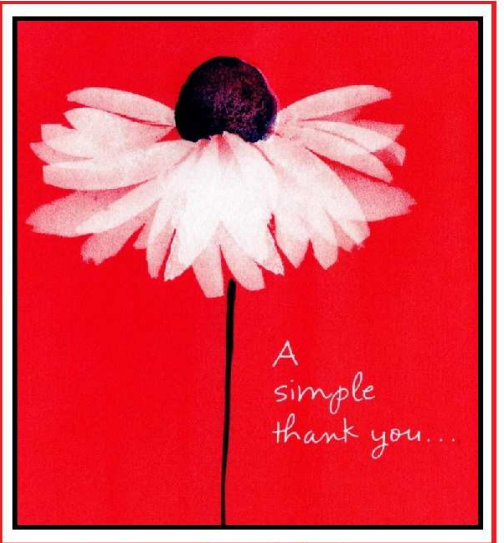

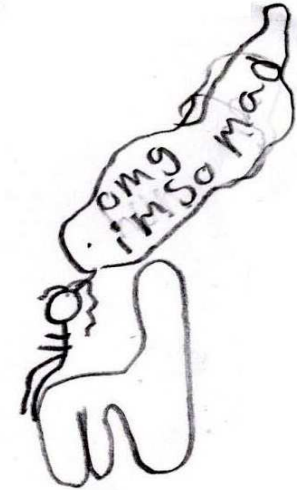
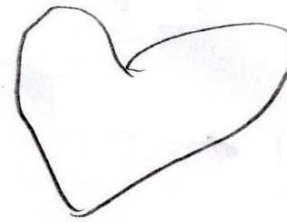


DEAR MR and MRS woodberry
